

Welcome to Spain!

Your trip starts at Bilbao Airport where our staff will meet you before the transfer to your hotel in San Sebastian.

After a brief orientation meeting, lunch and bike build-up, you'll head out on your first ride in the Basque Country. The warm-up ride takes you into the rolling hills to the south of San Sebastian before the climb to Igeldo and the incredibly scenic coastal road that leads back to the hotel in San Sebastian.

LIVE Race-Viewing: The Opening Stage

The 2023 Tour de France kicks off today with a magnificent stage, starting and finishing in Bilbao.

This is a unique opportunity to witness both the start and the finish of the Opening Stage of the Tour de France. You'll have privileged access to the VIP Departure Village, a great place to mingle and meet the riders as they prepare for the start of the 1st stage of the Tour de France. After the official departure, enjoy lunch in Bilbao before rounding off an amazing Tour de France day by witnessing the Race Finish from the VIP Tribune at the Finish Line in Bilbao.

A unique opportunity today to ride your bike across the Official Finish Line just a few hours before the peloton – followed by a photo shoot on the Official Podium. You'll round off an amazing Tour de France day by witnessing the finish of Stage 2 in San Sebastián.

In addition to all of the above, you'll also enjoy a spectacular ride through the rolling hills of the Basque Country to the medieval town of Hondarribia. Leaving Hondarribia you'll ride the legendary Jaizkibel climb, the ultimate climb in the annual Clásica San Sebastián pro race, and where you can expect to be cheered on by thousands of passionate Basque cycling fans.

Into the Pyrenees

The Tour de France leaves the Basque Country today and heads into France. We'll also say "adios" to Spain and head over to St Lary Soulan in the heart of the French Pyrenees.

After lunch at the hotel in St Lary, you'll head out on your first ride in the Pyrenees, over 2 classic Pyrenees climbs. From the hotel, enjoy the couple of km of flat through the quaint village streets, as soon as you exit St Lary you'll be on the lower slopes of today's first climb, the Col de Val Louron-Azet. Hope for clear weather today as the Val Louron offers magnificent views of the border with Spain and the highest peaks in the Pyrenees off to your right. From Val Louron you'll continue up the valley to Arreau and the classic climb to the Col d'Aspin.

Port de Balès (Chaingate)

Today's ride features one of our favorite Pyreneeen climbs. The Port de Bales was first introduced to the Tour de France in 2007 when a gravel forestry trail was asphalted allowing a connection between two valleys. It's probably best remembered for the "chaingate" incident in 2010 when Alberto Contador attacked Andy Schleck after Andy had dropped his chain.

Stunning scenery, no traffic, great pavement, fantastic views from the summit, and on a par with the Tourmalet in terms of difficulty all combine to make the Port de Bales one of our all-time favorite climbs. It's a long ride so our staff will advance you 50km in the vans, to the village of St Bertrand de Comminges. From St Bertrand you'll have a 10km warm-up before reaching Mauleon-Barousse and the start of the climb. From the summit, enjoy the great descent before the final climb of the day, the iconic Col de Peyresourde.

The stunning Cap de Long

One of the most beautiful and challenging climbs in the Pyrenees is the road that leads through the highest peaks in the Pyrenees to Lake Cap de Long, close to the Spanish border. The road winds its way through the Pyrenees Nature Reserve which essentially excludes it from ever being included in the Tour de France route. It is an absolute gem of a climb and regarded by many as their favorite climb in the Pyrenees. Today you'll have the opportunity to conquer this stunning climb followed by Tour de France favorite, the climb to Pla d'Adet – where George Hincapie won his only stage of the Tour de France in 2005.

Riding this legendary climb on race day will be an experience you're unlikely to forget. Enjoy!

Our Logistics Team will have set up our Race-Viewing Hospitality Marquee on the Tourmalet which will be buzzing with thousands of passionate fans excited to see the top riders battle it out on this famous climb. Enjoy the atmosphere from the comfort of our Private Hospitality Marquee. Food, drinks, and satellite TV race coverage will keep you entertained as you wait for the peloton to approach.
